- Real Red & White 6" X 6" (15.2 X 15.2 Cm) Glimmer Paper [159578]
- Basic Black 8-1/2" X 11" Cardstock [121045]
- Real Red 8-1/2" X 11" Cardstock [102482]
- Basic White 8 1/2" X 11" Thick Cardstock [159229]
- Versamark Pad [102283]
- Basics Embossing Powders [155554]
- Embossing Additions Tool Kit [159971]
- Black Stampin' Dimensionals Combo Pack [150893]
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue [110755]
- Heat Tool (Us And Canada) [129053]
- Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine [149653]

## Project Recipe:

	<p>1. Cuttin' It Up!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>* Thick Basic White - 5 1/2" x 8 1/2", scored at 4 1/4"</li><li>* Real Red - 4" x 5 1/4"</li><li>* Basic Black - scrap</li><li>* White Glimmer - scrap</li></ul>
	<p>2. Let's Make It!</p> <p>Run the scrap of Basic Black cardstock through the Stampin' Cut Emboss machine and the Splatters 3D embossing folder.</p> <p>Punch out the scottie dog.</p> <p>Punch out the bow from the scrap of White Glimmer paper.</p>
	<p>3. Rub the Embossing Buddy lightly over the Real Red cardstock. Ink the greeting in Versamark ink and stamp on the left of the card toward the bottom.</p> <p>Sprinkle with white embossing powder and heat.</p> <p>Stamp the set of three snowflakes randomly over the rest of the Real Red panel with Versamark ink, inking and stamping each time. Let dry slightly.</p>
	<p>4. Glue Real Red panel to the front of the folded card base.</p> <p>Add black dimensionals to the back of the scottie dog and adhere to the right of the greeting.</p> <p>Add a dab of liquid glue to the dog's neck and affix the bow.</p>
